Maskwa Medical Center – Ken Drysdale, Tab Pollock

Round table introductions were held.

The delegate was in attendance to present to council regarding the Maskwa Medical Center. The Maskwa Medical Center will play a pivotal role in the healthcare of Peace Country and Northwest Alberta residents and significantly impact the well-being of community members.

Ken introduced the project. Maskwa is an innovative, Alberta-based, not-for-profit registered charity committed to accelerating the process and improving access to medical specialists and family physicians. Any surplus funds from the tenancy of the building will be reinvested into research and education.

The Maskwa Medical Center is opening in Grande Prairie in 2026. It will have a specialist clinic where they will provide a treatment plan in 10 days from referral, retail will include a pharmacy, medical supply business, daycare, restaurant, etc., and an academic teaching clinic which will reduce ER visits by 50%, offer a 2-year program for family physicians and they expect 10 graduate students per year.

The ground breaking ceremony will take place in October and hopefully start the building construction this year. Suggestion was to have someone from the municipality join their membership to attend meetings twice a year.

They are requesting a letter of support from the municipality.
