

## **BYLAW 2013 - 17**

## THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17 In the Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 to provide for the Extension of Nomination Hours and to Establish Locations for Receipt of Nominations.

**WHEREAS**, Section 28(2) of the *Local Authorities Election Act* R.S.A 2000, Chapter L.21 provides that an elected authority may provide by bylaw passed prior to June 30 of a year in which an election is to be held, that the returning officer:

- a) May receive nominations earlier than 10:00 a.m.; and
- b) May establish locations, in addition to the local jurisdiction office, where a deputy may receive nominations;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 deems it expedient that, due to the large distances separating the local jurisdiction office and the wards, the hours for submission of nominations be extended; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 deems it expedient that, due to the large distances separating the local jurisdiction office and the wards, locations are established, in addition to the local jurisdiction office, where a deputy may receive nominations;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Council of Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the returning officer shall receive nominations at the local jurisdiction offices between 8:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon on nomination day.
- 2. That the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 Area Offices located in Red Earth Creek and Calling Lake be established as locations, in addition to the local jurisdiction office in Wabasca, where a deputy may receive nominations as per the set hours established herein.
- 3. That Bylaw 2007-15 is hereby repealed.
- 4. This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.

Read a second time this 12<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2013.

Read a third time and passed this 12<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2013.
