Trident Pump Inc. - Kevin Younker

Round Table Introductions

The delegate was in attendance to present to council the Trident Pump System and explained how it works. The Trident Community Protection System is comprised of one patented trident pump, hose deployer and sprinkler/handline connections. The configuration of the pump and hose deployer built on an off-high vehicle platform creates a mobile system that can be rapidly deployed once on site, with multi-use water thieves every 200 feet. It takes a four-member crew to run it.

Trident systems don't carry any water; they utilize remote standing water instead and have a pump capacity of 2,000 gpm, with the ability to push water through 4" layflat for at least 8,000' (1.5 miles) at distance and elevation.

It takes about 6 weeks to build one system. A maintenance kit comes with every system. There is a three-year warranty for defects. Training is also available to set up and run the equipment and is free with the purchase of a system. It is a two-day course and there are refresher courses which can be taken online.
