UTILITIES POLICY

TITLE: RESIDENTIAL WATER & SEWER MAIN LINE INSTALLATION

EFFECTIVE DATE: JUNE 22, 2022

POLICY NUMBER: UT. 4

Purpose of Policy:

This policy is intended to set out the guidelines and circumstances where the Municipal District of Opportunity will install main line water and sewer services within the hamlets of the municipality.

Policy Statements

- 1. The municipality will install water or sewer main line and service(s) to the existing residential parcels of a hamlet where it has been determined that there will be an environmental impact without these service(s).
- The municipality will only install main services as described above if the hamlet's water and sewage treatment facilities are capable of servicing the proposed distribution and collection systems.
- 3. The municipality shall install these services as described above only up to the property line unless Council decides otherwise.
- 4. When the municipality installs these main line services as described above and up to the property line, it will be done without any direct cost to the property owner as referred to in Section 34 of the *Municipal Government Act*.
- 5. The land owner shall be responsible for all costs associated with hooking up to the water or sewer services line.
- The Municipality's trucked water delivery and trucked sewage removal services will not be provided at the subsidized rates if the residences are adjacent to water & sewer main line services.
